As she opened her front door she found a baby girl on her doorstep, without any clothes on. The baby was very cold and frightened so Allen took her into her house that night and reported the matter to the Local Council chairman the next day. Efforts to identify the parents were not successful, and so the baby was handed over to the local police to find her a suitable home. On 13<sup>th</sup> June, the Child & Family Protection Unit at the Wakiso Police Station brought her to KCC.

We have named her Elise Faith Sanyu and she is now living in Mukisa House on site – she is settling in well and enjoying having lots of brothers and sisters to cuddle her!
