Q&A IDEAS...



Usually after an assembly they'll be opportunity for a 'question and answer' session between the pupils and the choir. It can be a good idea to encourage students to think before hand of questions they'd like to ask. If there's time, the choir will also ask questions to some of your pupils.

The choir have always enjoyed answering questions and it's a great way to provide interaction. To give you ideas, here are some examples from previous Tours.....

- 1.** How many times have you been to UK?
- 2.** How long was your journey to the UK?
- 3.** How did you get here?
- 4.** Do you enjoy living at Kampala Children's Centre?
- 5.** How long have you lived at Kampala Children's Centre?
- 6.** Do you go to school / what school etc – any questions relating to school – favourite subjects / what do you do in playtime / do you have homework / how do you get to school / how long is your school day etc.
- 7.** Questions relating to food – what do you eat in Uganda / what is your favourite food / what have you eaten in the UK / what is your favourite English food etc
- 8.** Do you like football and which football team do you support in England?
- 9.** What is your favourite song or dance that you perform?
- 10.** What are the drums made of?
- 11.** Questions relating to the performance – how long does it take to learn the dances and songs / How long do you practice for in Uganda / Where do you practice etc
- 12.** What do you like to do in your playtimes at home / any hobbies etc
- 13.** How long have you been in Destiny Africa for?
- 14.** How many people are in Destiny Africa / have some stayed in Uganda?
- 15.** Who trains you and teaches you in Uganda?
- 16.** Questions relating to the differences between UK and Uganda – e.g, what is the weather like / do you have buses and cars in Uganda etc
- 17.** What is the best thing about living at Kampala Children's Centre?
- 18.** What is your housemother called / what do you like to do with her at home?
- 19.** What is the best thing you have ever done in Destiny Africa / any highlights etc
- 20.** What do you do for Christmas or Easter?
- 21.** How do you drum so fast?
- 22.** What is your house at KCC made out of?
- 23.** How many live in your home with you?
- 24.** How do you study on tour?
- 25.** Do you enjoy touring and being in Destiny Africa?

Note: We ask that questions relating to the children's personal histories or sensitive issues such as death of parents etc. are avoided.
